



BC Freight Cost Surcharge

January 14th 2022

To our Valued Customers,

Throughout the past few months, transportation throughout British Columbia continues to be severely impacted by the extreme weather that has occurred in late 2021. Combined with an overall shortage in carrier availability and general labor shortage from the ongoing pandemic this has resulted in significant shipping cost increases in our province.

As a result, our suppliers have been forced to announce a 5% price increase for all poly items delivered into British Columbia. Though every effort has been made to hold our position, this continued cost pressure has necessitated an unexpected surcharge effective January 17th 2022.

This increase/freight surcharge will be in place for a limited time effective January 17th 2022 until further notice. ICS Clean Supplies will continue to monitor this highly fluid situation and communicate further market changes related to freight costs and/or supply issue.

ICS Clean Supplies will continue to absorb as much of this unexpected increase as possible and work closely with all clients to ensure the highest quality goods and services are provided.
