RECYCLING GUIDE

CHEMICAL CONTENT BOTTLES & CONTAINERS

Following these 3 recycling steps we can ensure businesses and consumers properly dispose of any containers, bottles and packaging material(s) associated when using our products. HDPE 2 (High-Density Polyethylene) is used in most containers which can be easily recycled in your "Blue Bin" recycling program or at a Recycle BC depot.



FAQ'S

WHAT IF MY CHEMICAL CONTAINER IS NOT MADE FROM HDPE 2 (High-Density Polyethylene)?

If your container is not an HDPE 2 container, you can simply check the bottle or packaging to review the bottle type. If your packaging is made from LDPE/HDPE is accepted in any "Blue Bin" recycling program in BC

WHAT IF THE CHEMICAL CONTENTS IS A HAZARDOUS MATERIAL, LIKE ANTI-FREEZE?

If your chemical contents is hazardous or contains a precautionary octagon or diamond symbol this will require specialty, safe disposal as any containments will effect the rest of the recycling load or garbage. Please contact the Recycling Council of BC for sage disposal options.

WHAT IF I HAVE CONTENTS LEFT IN MY BOTTLE?

If you have contents left in the bottle, please refer to the specific container label for safe chemical disposal before recycling.

FAQ'S CONT'

WHAT IF MY BOTTLE STILL HAS A LABEL AND CAP?

You do NOT have to remove the labels, they can remain affixed to your plastic packaging as they can be lifted off during recycling processes. All caps can be recycled with your bottles.

WHAT IF MY CHEMICAL CONTENTS PACKAGING IS LARGER THAN A 25L's?

You can recycle all pails up to 25L in your regular recycling program, any pails larger should be disposed of via a commercial hauler.

WHAT IF I AM NOT SURE?

FAQ'S CONT'

WHAT IF MY CHEMICAL BOTTLE IS AN AEROSOL?

Recycle BC accepts select aerosol containers for food, air fresheners, hair spray, etc. Once verified, you will empty the contents of the can safety, remove the cap and place both pieces loose in your recycling container.

WHAT ABOUT THE PUMP?

If your chemical container comes with a pump, you will remove from bottle and place loose in your "Blue Bin" recycling container.



RECYCLING GUIDE

CARDBOARD PACKAGING MATERIAL(S)

Following these 3 recycling steps we can ensure businesses and consumers properly dispose of any packaging material(s) associated when using and/or receiving our products. 90-100% of all our packaging is made with renewable material, all of which can all be easily recycled in your "Blue Bin" recycling program or at a Recycle BC depot.



FAQ'S

WHAT IF I PRODUCT CONTENTS LEFT OVER IN MY PACKAGING BOX?

IF you have product content left over such as tissue(s) or paper towel, these can be recycled with your cardboard box

WHAT DO I DO WITH THE CORES OF MY PRODUCT?
All toilet tissue cores can be recycled with your product content packaging in your Recycle BC "Blue Bin"

HOW SHOULD I FLATTEN MY PACKAGING BOXES?

When preparing to recycle your cardboard boxes, you will want to flatten large corrugated boxes and cut down to no larger than 30" wide (78cm) x 30in tall (78cm). Staples and tape are okay to be left.

WHAT IF MY PACKAGING HAS A WAX COATING?

Any packaging containing wax coating are not accepted.



RECYCLING GUIDE

PLASTIC PACKAGING & CARTRIDGE MATERIAL(S)

Following these 3 recycling steps we can ensure businesses and consumers properly dispose of any plastic packaging material(s) associated will our cartridge soaps & sanitizers. Our cartridges are made from recyclable plastics and fully collapsible which can all be easily recycled in your "Blue Bin" recycling program or at a Recycle BC depot.

WHAT IF I HAVE CONTENTS LEFT IN MY BOTTLE?


EQUIPMENT RECYCLIING & REFURBISHING

THE FIVE STEPS IN OUR TAKE-BACK PROGRAM:




Hundreds of used machines returned each year

As the refurbishing team takes back a machie, it is carefully examined for faults and wear.



RECYCLING of worn-out parts

The team decides either to refurbish or dismantle the machine. All parts, such as batteries, plastic, metal and electrics can be traced and potentially recycled.



Machine is ready for a NEW CUSTOMER

If the machine is refurbished it is thoroughly cleaned and often sandblasted, to look as good as new. Fault or worn-out parts are replaced by new parts. Once complete, the machine is ready to be sold or rented to a new customer as a second-hand machine.
